EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES (INTRA-COMMUNITY TRANSFERS OF DEFENCE RELATED PRODUCTS) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2014

I, RICHARD BRUTON, Minister for Jobs, Enterprise and Innovation, in exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 3 of the European Communities Act 1972 (No. 27 of 1972) and for the purpose of giving effect to Commission Directive 2014/18/EU of 29 January 2014¹ amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products, hereby make the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the European Communities (Intra-Community Transfers of Defence Related Products) (Amendment) Regulations 2014.

2. Regulation 2 (amended by the European Communities (Intra-Community Transfers of Defence Related Products) (Amendment) Regulations 2013 (S.I. No. 87 of 2013)) of the European Communities (Intra-Community Transfers of Defence Related Products) Regulations 2011 (S.I. No. 346 of 2011), is amended, in paragraph (1), by substituting the following definition for the definition of “Directive”:

“ ‘Directive’ means Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 6 May 2009² simplifying terms and conditions of transfers of defence-related products within the Community as amended by—

- (a) Commission Directive 2010/80/EU of 22 November 2010³ amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products,
- (b) Commission Directive 2012/10/EU of 22 March 2012⁴ amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products,
- (c) Commission Directive 2012/47/EU of 14 December 2012⁵ amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products, and
- (d) Commission Directive 2014/18/EU of 29 January 2014⁶ amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products;”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the instrument and does not purport to be a legal interpretation.)

- (d) Commission Directive 2014/48/EU of 29 January 2014 amending Directive 2009/43/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council as regards the list of defence-related products;”.
